APPLICATION PROCESS 2020

Please read carefully so that the process is as smooth as possible and correctly completed.

All members of Adelaide Gang Show are required to be screened through the Scout Association, as either a Uniformed Member or as an Adult Volunteer.

In line with Scouts SA, Adelaide Gang Show will be using the MyScout system for applications for all members for this season.

To apply for Adelaide Gang Show, you need to complete the following steps.

Step 1: Registering for Auditions (Cast only)

1. Follow the link to Trybooking: <https://www.trybooking.com/BGCYI>
2. Register and select one audition session.

Each person attending the audition must have a separate booking in their own name.

You will receive a confirmation email from Trybooking, you will not need to bring a ticket with you to the audition.

Step 2: Adelaide Gang Show Membership Application Process (Cast and Crew)

You will need to log onto MyScout (<https://sa.myscout.com.au/events/56/registration>) to complete Adelaide Gang Show 2020 season event Application.

To Apply through MyScout please follow the attached link; you will need your date of birth and your Scout Member number.

1. If you do not know your Scout member number, you can access it by contacting your Scout Group or if you have been a member of Adelaide Gang Show in the past you can contact the Administration Director.
2. If you are a **Girl Guide** or are **not currently a Member of Scouts SA Branch**, please contact the Administration Director to assist processing your Application.

All members of Adelaide Gang Show and Scouts SA are required to hold a current National Police Clearance, and in line with legislation a Working with Children Check. We will be able to assist through this process.

Step 3: CareMonkey (Cast and Crew)

If you are successful in being accepted as a member of the Adelaide Gang Show Cast or Crew, you will be sent a link to share your CareMonkey Profile with us. CareMonkey is used to manage the Health and Welfare of our Members, and the administration of forms throughout our season.

If you already have a profile please share with Adelaide Gang Show, alternatively you will be prompted to create a profile. To participate in Adelaide Gang Show activities all Cast and Crew members must be registered on CareMonkey.
