ESSENTIAL CAST INFORMATION

This document provides essential information for those interested in becoming part of our CAST. Share this information widely. If you know of anyone else in your Group who would like to apply, give them our website address www.adelaidegangshow.com.au so they can learn about us.

Applicants are required to fill out the Online Application Form at <https://sasas.sa.scouts.com.au/login.asp>. To be a member of the 2019 Cast, you must be a registered member of either the Scout or Guide Associations. You must be available to audition on one of the four dates and also attend all rehearsals including two weekend rehearsals and one Sunday rehearsal. Performances are held at the Scott Theatre in September 2019. If successful, you will be notified prior to the Gang Show Get Together on 6th May 2019. At this evening, you will be divided into Patrols (just like in your scout troops) and be introduced to your Patrol and Assistant Patrol Leaders. You will also meet other key members of the Production and Crew departments on this night.

ESSENTIAL CREW INFORMATION

Applicants are required to fill out the Online Application Form at <https://sasas.sa.scouts.com.au/login.asp>. If you are over 18, you do not need to be a current registered member of the Scout or Guide Associations. Parents and friends are encouraged to apply. There are many departments that support Adelaide Gang Show, so there might just be something for you. Why not learn a new skill, or perhaps you have a valuable skill that we can showcase! Please note that there are limitations regarding the number of people per department, age limitations and other exclusion criteria may apply for some departments. Heads of Departments have the right to select their team from the applications. There is a comprehensive list 'Crew Profiles' about each department, expectations, costs and conditions on our website, I would encourage you to review this list.

If you are under 18, a few of our crew departments allow for members who are under 18 to be involved. However, it is now a requirement that ALL CREW members who are under 18 and of scout age (6 years to 18 years old), be registered and financial with Scouts SA. WHAT IS INVOLVED AS CREW

The commitment will vary based on each department. Some departments require you only to attend during the theatre season while others would like your help at rehearsals, or Wednesday nights or even Thursdays during the day. See the Crew Profiles on the website for details.

Adelaide Gang Show is committed to ensure the health, safety and wellbeing of all of its cast and crew. In accordance with Scouts SA Policy, adult crew members will be required to complete an A2 Adult Helper Application Form which includes a valid National Police check. There is no charge to the applicant for the National Police clearances and once confirmed by Scouts SA are valid for 3 years. You will be required to provide Adelaide Gang Show with emergency contact details and medical information. Some details of the medical record may be shared with senior members of the show to ensure your continued health, safety and wellbeing. This information will be kept confidential and secure. Please be assured that this information will continue to remain confidential and be treated with the utmost respect.

As an Adult in our youth movement, you will be required to complete any training or learning modules as directed by Scouts SA and Adelaide Gang Show, and adhere to the Code of Conduct for adults in Scouting. There is no cost incurred by the adult helper to complete this training.

COSTS

All cast and crew of Adelaide Gang Show pay the show fees. You can check the Crew Profiles for expected costs for each department. Fundraising discounts can apply if participating in any of our fundraising activities. This cost is payable upon acceptance into the show and is required to be paid before Opening Night. Payment plans are available and should be discussed with the Finance Director, Mr John Bohmer at the first rehearsal.

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Crew have an opportunity to purchase a Gang Show Polo Top at a cost of \$28.00 or a Hoodie at a cost of \$38.00 if they choose. This is not compulsory. Many departments wear 'blacks' (black clothing) during performances. Your Head of Department can provide further details. There is also RatPack merchandise available to any over 18 members nearer to the theatre. Information will be provided when this is available.

Included in the fees, our catering team provide water, cordial and a snack available throughout rehearsals and performances. During all day and weekend rehearsals, appropriate meals will be provided to the required crew. When at rehearsals a small canteen offers drinks and snacks which crew may purchase during the night.
